

This pattern is passed from a friend of mine who learned from a friend of hers. It is rather loose directions because you can alter them for the size of shawl, afghan, etc. The main thing to remember is - Chain 3.

Sawtooth Crochet Pattern

Make a chain the length you want.

Row 1- 3 DC in 4th chain from hook, * skip 3 chains, SC in next chain, chain 3, 3 DC in same chain. Repeat from * across row. End with: SC in next chain.

This next row may be omitted if you get too confused with the directions. Remember I was taught by someone sitting with me. Writing the directions and reading them is different than having an actual person showing you what to do next.

If you omit the next row, at the end, you will then continue around the three unfinished sides to give the sawtooth edge.

Row 2- At the end of Row 1, chain 5, turn upside down so you are crocheting into the bottom of row 1,* SC in the chain 3-space from the previous row, chain 3 , DC 3x in the same CH 3-space, Repeat from * across the row. At the end of the row Chain 3, turn.

Row 3- *SC in the chain 3-space from the previous row, chain 3, DC 3X in the same Ch 3-space, Repeat from * across the row. At the end of the row, Chain 3, turn.

Repeat Row 3 until the desired length.

Your shawl should have finished with the sawtooth edge all around. If you omitted the original Row 2, upside down row, then when you reach the length you want, continue the pattern stitch around the 3 unfinished edges to give the sawtooth edge.
