

## YARN OVER PRAYER SHAWL

Size 11 or 13 needles  
3 skeins Homespun Yarn by Lion Brand

Note: This pattern will make the shawl a little wider than the K3,P3 so you might want to make a swatch first. If you want fringe, leave about 3 oz from your 3rd skein. I weigh my yarn on my kitchen scale. I did not have but about 24" left.

Cast on 57 or 63 sts. (or less)

Rows 1,2,3 and 4, knit.

Row 5 K1, yarn over, k1.....continue to end of row. (you'll have double the number of stitches you started with).

Row 6 K1, drop off the yarn over stitch, K1.....cont' to end of row.

(You will have the number of sts you started with. Count your stitches frequently, it's easy to wind up with more or less.

These 6 rows make the pattern. Just end with row 4, then bind off.

Add whatever edging. And no, I did not knot the ends of the fringe, I like the fluffy look. You can put the shawl in the dryer on cool air with a fabric softener sheet (if one is not allergic) for about 1 minute or less. Makes it soft.
