- * Believe that they are eating and drinking Christ's body and blood
- Matthew 28:19-20
- 1 Corinthians 11:27:29
- 1 Corinthians 11:23-25
- Believe they need what is offered in this sacrament, namely the forgiveness of sins, the strengthening of faith, and the power to lead a godly life Ephesians 4:22-24

Those who wish to participate in the Lord's Supper at TLC are requested to sign the "Fellowship Form" and register for communion. Individual cups containing grape juice placed at the center of the tray for those sensitive to alcohol. <u>Children and</u>

others not communing are invited to come to the altar to receive a blessing. Indicate your desire to receive a blessing by crossing vour arms over vour chest.
