EXTENSION Are you a type 2 diabetic or a caregiver of a loved one with type 2 diabetes? Would you like to learn how to better manage your diabetes? If so, please join us for "Do Well, Be Well with Diabetes! Do Well, Be Well with Diabetes is an educational program for people with type 2 diabetes. The classes will be conducted by area physicians and health and nutrition professionals. The five week series will address topics such as The One Diabetes Diet, Managing Your Blood Sugar, Dietary Treatment, Foot Care, Diabetes Medicines, Eating Out and much, much more. The classes are scheduled for August 6th, 13th, 20th 27th and Sept 4th. All classes will be conducted on Mondays at 6:30 p.m. at the Texas AgriLife Extension Office located at 20 S. Holland in Bellville, TX. A blood glucose monitoring system will be provided for each registered participant. Pre-registration will run from now until July 30 and the cost for the program is \$25.00 per person. Add \$5.00 as of July 31st (\$30.00). Evening refreshments will be served at each meeting. Care givers of type 2 diabetes individuals are encouraged to participate too. The primary goal is to help participants learn how to manage their meal plan and self-care to maintain their blood glucose in the ranges recommended by the American Diabetes Association.
