# Preparation for Holy Communion



**ALL who commune today are encouraged to prepare themselves by using the "Christian Questions with Their Answers" section of Luther's Small Catechism found on page 329 of the hymnal.**

As a congregation of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, we celebrate communion believing that we receive the true body and true blood of Christ for the forgiveness of sins and the strengthening of faith. As such, we invite all to our altar who share our belief and teaching concerning the Lord's Supper. All are welcome to commune who:

- \* Are Baptized Christians Matthew 28:19-20
- \* Are able to properly examine themselves recognizing their sinfulness 1 Corinthians 11:27-29
- \* Believe that they are eating and drinking Christ's body and blood 1 Corinthians 11:23-25
- \* Believe they need what is offered in this sacrament, namely the forgiveness of sins, the strengthening of faith, and the power to lead a godly life Ephesians 4:22-24

Those who wish to participate in the Lord's Supper at TLC are requested to sign the "Fellowship Form" and register for communion. Individual cups containing grape juice placed at the center of the tray for those sensitive to alcohol. Children and others not communing are invited to come to the altar to receive a blessing. Indicate your desire to receive a blessing by crossing your arms over your chest.

 **AgriLIFE EXTENSION** Are you a type 2 diabetic or a caregiver of a loved one with type 2 diabetes? Would you like to learn how to better manage your diabetes? If so, please join us for “Do Well, Be Well with Diabetes! Do Well, Be Well with Diabetes is an educational program for people with type 2 diabetes. The classes will be conducted by area physicians and health and nutrition professionals. The five week series will address topics such as The One Diabetes Diet, Managing Your Blood Sugar, Dietary Treatment, Foot Care, Diabetes Medicines, Eating Out and much, much more. The classes are scheduled for August 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> 27<sup>th</sup> and Sept 4<sup>th</sup>. All classes will be conducted on Mondays at 6:30 p.m. at the Texas AgriLife Extension Office located at 20 S. Holland in Bellville, TX. A blood glucose monitoring system will be provided for each registered participant. Pre-registration will run from now until July 30 and the cost for the program is \$25.00 per person. Add \$5.00 as of July 31<sup>st</sup> (\$30.00). Evening refreshments will be served at each meeting. Care givers of type 2 diabetes individuals are encouraged to participate too. The primary goal is to help participants learn how to manage their meal plan and self-care to maintain their blood glucose in the ranges recommended by the American Diabetes Association. The program is being sponsored by Texas AgriLife Extension Service, Bellville General Hospital, and the Texas Department of Health and Human Services. Register
