Preparation for Holy Communion



ALL who commune today are encouraged to prepare themselves by using the “Christian Questions with Their Answers” section of Luther’s Small Catechism found on page 329 of the hymnal.

As a congregation of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, we celebrate communion believing that we receive the true body and true blood of Christ for the forgiveness of sins and the strengthening of faith. As such, we invite all to our altar who share our belief and teaching concerning the Lord’s Supper. All are welcome to commune who:

- * Are Baptized Christians Matthew 28:19-20
- * Are able to properly examine themselves recognizing their sinfulness 1 Corinthians 11:27:29
- * Believe that they are eating and drinking Christ’s body and blood 1 Corinthians 11:23-25
- * Believe they need what is offered in this sacrament, namely the forgiveness of sins, the strengthening of faith, and the power to lead a godly life Ephesians 4:22-24

Those who wish to participate in the Lord’s Supper at TLC are requested to sign the “Fellowship Form” and register for communion. Individual cups containing grape juice placed at the center of the tray for those sensitive to alcohol. Children and others not communing are invited to come to the altar to receive a blessing. Indicate your desire to receive a blessing by crossing your arms over your chest.

The Ministry of the Month: Lutheran Heritage Foundation

“Consider yourself as an instructor in a classroom where are all the textbooks are written in languages only known to you, but totally unknown to the students. Can you imagine the frustration of your students? We were helplessly dealing with this situation when LHF came to help,” Rev. Gregoire Legbanon, President of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Benin. Imagine trying to understand Scripture in all its richness without the benefit of *Luther’s Small Catechism* or trying to teach young children basic Bible stories without books like *A Child’s Garden of Bible Stories*. For Lutheran churches around the world, these situations are reality. They don’t have the basic books, so vital to understand the Lutheran faith, because no one has translated them into their languages. In more than 70 countries and 90 languages, thousands of people have come to faith in Christ because they’ve been able to read books like *The Good News About Jesus* or *Luther’s Small Catechism* in their own languages. The Lutheran Heritage Foundation has published the catechism in more than 50 languages, and 15 additional translations have been requested. In the past decade, LHF has published and distributed more than 450 titles and 3 million Lutheran books to pastors, seminary students, missionaries and churches – all at no cost to them. **The project that our church will be supporting** is the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Sudan and the theological training of pastors at a seminary in southern Sudan. Support is used to send theological instructors from the U.S. and other countries to train the men currently enrolled in the seminary program. Funding also underwrites the room, board, and upkeep of the students as they study away from their families. Throughout this month, please pray for the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Sudan and the men training to be pastors at the seminary there. If you would like to make a donation to LHF, during the month of August, look for canisters in the back of the sanctuary where you can place your donations to support the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Sudan and its seminary through the Lutheran Heritage Foundation.
