FEBRUARY 11, 2013**

The Trinity Lutheran Church Council Meeting was called to order by President George Wied and opened with prayer. President Wied presented a devotion from Portals of Prayer from Nehemiah.

Council Members Absent: Dale Toellner, Vice President; Rachel Wolf - Education Chair, Rhonda Pavelka - Youth Chair

Visitor Present - Troy Tesch, BBQ

Minutes from the January 2013 meeting were presented for review and approval. Lee Hobratschk made motion to accept minutes. Norma Pavelka seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

Unfinished/Old Business:

\*Fred Paben and Janice Wied will meet Wednesday, February 13th to discuss pictorial directory.  
\*Discussion on BBQ to rent 3 pits at KC Hall to cook meat, put in coolers and bring to Fellowship Center to serve in to go lines. Troy Tesch gave input regarding the BBQ cooking team and would need more people to transport meat. By having the BBQ at the Fellowship Center and cooking meat at KC Hall pits would save around \$1,300. Additional plans are still being worked on by George Wied. Motion made by Lee Hobratschk to have Church BBQ at Fellowship Center, rent pits from KC Hall to cook meat, have auction and youth activities on August 11, 2013 from 11 am to 1 pm serving. Ruth Szymanski seconded the motion. All approved. Motion carried.

Chair Reports:

Linda Blume - Treasurer

\*The January 31, 2013 Treasurer's Report was presented. The cash balances in the General Fund is (\$7,149.43), Building Fund is \$68,184.62, Designated Funds is \$44,257.78 and Total - All Funds is \$105,292.97. The General Fund Contributions is \$13,669.81. Total management and general expenses is \$11,267.93. The Excess (deficit) of contributions over expenses is \$2,401.88.

\*The Thanksgiving, Advent, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day offerings have been transferred into general fund.

Jerry Leiber - Stewardship Chair

\*Offering envelopes need to be ordered by April 1st for savings. Jerry will order 2 units (225 boxes per unit) instead of 3 units as previously ordered.

Ruth Szymanski - Evangelism Chair

\*Discussion on Visitor Center and gifts for visitors  
\*Maggie Kent sends visitor names to Ruth and she sends them a card.

\*Pastor Franke will forward information on Evangelism to her.

Fred Paben - Trustee Chair

\*Media screens were cleaned by Johnnie Busse and Pat Buechmann.

\*Historical Marker - A family will match what is collected already to cover the remaining contribution needed to purchase marker.

\*The Summary for Building and BPP from The Littleton Group (insurance company) for Fellowship Center roof was presented. A bid from Extreme Roofing was presented to replace with same type roofing for an out of pocket estimate of \$17,627 with an upgrade to metal out of pocket estimate of \$60,834. Fred will get more bids for roof and will also check on fire insurance rate for metal roof vs. composition shingle roof .

Lee Hobradsch - Elder Chair

\*Pastor Franke is still working with no written contract which is being worked on.

\*Linda inquired to Pastor Franke if he has a housing allowance for 2013.

\*Delinquent member list - A letter will be sent to members that have been inactive a year or more with a response needed. If no response is received then member will be put on an inactive list or dropped.

\*Discussion on active vs. inactive members using facilities for member pricing.

Rachel Wolf - Education Chair (not present) Audra Luttrall presented report by email on February 12th after close of meeting:

\*Board of Education helped with the "Over 70's" Valentine lunch on February 10th and gave a homemade white chocolate candy party favor to each attendee. The Sunday School children made Valentines that were placed on the tables at the luncheon.

\*For the Youth Soup at Lenten Supper on February 27th, the Board members will help by also providing soup.

\*The Board is planning to host a Palm Sunday celebration during Sunday School on March 24th, in lieu of the traditional Easter egg hunt that has been hosted in the past. The Board plans to have a short Bible story, activity, snack and piñata with all the Sunday School children.

\*Volunteers are still needed to teach Sunday School, for all age groups, but especially for High School (for which there is currently no teacher and no attendance). Any help for the youth would be greatly appreciated.

\*There were 67 people that attended the fellowship luncheon on January 27th.
