## **"EASTER TRIUMPH, EASTER JOY!"**

Easter time is filled with joy. There is the joy of friendship. We know what it is like to greet a good friend we haven't seen in years. Imagine the joy of Jesus' friends, who had watched while he was put to death, when they met him on that first Easter Day! Hurrying away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, the women suddenly met Jesus. "Greetings," he said. "Go tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me." (*Matthew 28:10 NIV*)

Imagine the joy of two friends, walking along a road leading from Jerusalem, discussing the disturbing news of the past several days with a stranger, when they sat down to a meal and suddenly recognized that the "stranger" was their dearest friend!

Easter is filled with the joy of victory. It is good to celebrate a win, whether it is a sports meet, an academic contest, or a personal triumph. We set goals and celebrate accomplishments. The victory God has given us in Christ includes the goal of heaven. His defeat of death is an accomplished fact. "We are more than conquerors through him who loved us. . . . Nothing in all creation will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." (*Romans 8:37-39 NIV*)

Easter is filled with the joy of forgiveness. When friendship is ruptured by some deep hurt or injustice, the ongoing pain of the broken relationship is greater than the first wrong. When the first "I'm sorry!" tears are shed and a handclasp or hug seals the restoration of fellowship, it is as though a new life is begun. Easter joy is the creation of a pure heart and the renewal of a steadfast spirit.

Easter joy reassures us that Jesus' friendship is for eternity, not just for today. Jesus' victory over sin and death is an accomplishment, not just a goal. Jesus' forgiveness is the restoration of a broken relationship. In Christ, God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting our sins against us, but making Jesus, who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we may be the righteousness of God.

Each year the preschool comes together with St. Jude's Research Hospital to teach the children the importance of bike safety while raising money for childhood cancer research. Bike safety week will be Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>- Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup>.

St. Jude's Research Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee is the first institution established for the sole purpose of conducting basic and clinical

research into catastrophic childhood diseases, mainly cancer.

St. Jude's Research Hospital sends us a week long program that teaches the children about bike safety with story color sheets, reading book and DVD. The DVD is about Bikewell Bear and lessons about bike safety.

We are asking each child to donate \$1.00 or more that would go towards St. Jude's Research Hospital to help families in need with the cost of treatments for their child who has cancer.

St. Jude's Research Hospital was founded by the late entertainer Danny Thomas. The hospital is an internationally recognized biomedical research hospital dedicated to childhood cancer. Patients' care and research are supported through funds raised by ALSAC, which is American Lebanese Syrian Associated Charities.

ALSAC covers all cost not covered by insurance for medical treatment rendered at St. Jude's Research Hospital. Families without insurance are never asked to pay. With the support of you and others more than 18,750 patients have been successfully treated at St. Jude's Research Hospital.

As a preschool we teach the children about what donations are and how we can help families in need. With each child's donation of \$1.00 or more to St. Jude's Research Hospital for support, we can help millions around the world both through increased safety and cancer research and treatment. Let's try to raise as much money as we can to help these families in need.




