Three congregations of the Lutheran Church in the Philippines (LCP), a partner with The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod, are in the area hardest hit by Typhoon Haiyan, which tore through the country Friday, Nov. 8 and is one of the strongest storms ever recorded.
