## Exercise Your Right of Gratitude

*"But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." – Matthew 6:33 NIV*

Some wit has said, "If Galileo were living today, he would prove the whole universe revolved around **him!**" That may be true. It does seem we have moved toward an egocentric social mindset: "You deserve a break today;" "I gotta' be me;" "Just do it;" "Don't hold me back."

This "me mania" gets us into trouble when we think we deserve all the good things we want in life. There are two serious symptoms that show up in our lives when we begin to live as though we were entitled to a three bedroom house full of furniture, a wall-sized flatscreen TV, a two car garage, 4G cellular telephone, broadband wireless internet, and the like.

First of all, we don't mind doing whatever it takes to get them. That runs all the way from taking advantage of a friend to stealing from an employer. "After all, I'm not getting the salary I deserve!"

Even worse, this "self-deserving" attitude takes away our gratitude. There is no reason to thank anyone for something you deserve. Jesus himself said, "Would the master thank the servant because he did what he was supposed to do?" The expected answer is, "Of course not!" Do you thank your boss for your weekly paycheck? Do you thank the utilities company for providing electricity or water when you pay for it?

Why would you bother to thank anyone for those things you deserve? Well, you might, to be polite, but surely not out of gratitude. There is nothing to be grateful for if you only receive things that you have earned.

God certainly gives us a great gift: he entitles us to gratitude. He does that by giving us much more than we need or deserve. The first bountiful blessing from his hand is forgiveness for our sins and eternal life with him through Jesus Christ his Son! Beyond that he showers on us all our physical blessings as well.

*"Seek first God's kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well." None of us deserved to be born in this land of American plenty. The identity of life itself, that each of us is able to say, "I," "me," or "mine" is a gift, pure, simple, and undeserved.*

With every gift from God's gracious hand he preserves our right to give him thanks! That is the one thing we are entitled to! Exercise your right to be grateful. Say "Thank You!"

We are getting ready for our Sixteenth Annual Preschool Congregational Thanksgiving Dinner, which will be on **Thursday November 13<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 5:30 p.m. and ending at 7:00 p.m.** The cost of the ticket is \$9.00. This is the major fundraiser for the preschool which helps with the cost for teacher training, criminal background and fingerprinting of teachers, playground upkeep, classroom toys, supplies, snacks, repairs, carpet cleaning, exterminating, fire inspections, gas inspections etc., or for whatever else arises in the year. The proceeds from the Thanksgiving Dinner will help replace timbers around the wooden playground and set aside funds for bills to get through the summer.

Since this is a fundraiser to benefit the preschool, we need parents and church members to donate food items towards the dinner. This is posted on the large glass window as you enter the preschool. We are in need of **sixty-five** turkeys and you can purchase a turkey for \$12.00 and make the check out to Trinity Lutheran Preschool or you can give cash. Please place your check or cash in an envelope and bring it to the preschool office. We will make one check out to H E B in Columbus, since we are purchasing the turkeys from them. Please have your turkey money donation in the office by Wednesday November 5<sup>th</sup>, so I can pick up the turkeys on Friday morning to deliver to Mikeska's in Columbus to be pit smoked.

The cost to pit smoke the turkeys is around \$650.00. Mikeska's in Columbus smokes the turkeys for the preschool. It would be a big help if you would like to donate money towards the smoking of the turkeys. With your help you can donate in \$5.00 increments. Make your check out to Trinity Lutheran Preschool or cash and place this in the envelope provided. All donations will need to be in the preschool or church office by Wednesday, November 5<sup>th</sup> so I can pay Mikeska's when I pick up the turkeys the day of the dinner.

We also in need of **thirty-five** huge cans of the corn, **thirty-five** huge cans of green beans, **thirty-five** cans huge yams, **six** huge cans of cranberry sauce, **thirty** desserts and **thirty-five** loaves of bread, which you can order and pick up from Bill's Country Market. Please feel free to take a look at the thanksgiving dinner fundraiser sign up list and write your name on the items you wish to donate. Bring items to the preschool as soon as you have purchased them. This will give me an idea of what I need to purchase for the dinner. You can

see how expensive this event can be, but with all the parents and congregation donating food items, this will be a success.

During the dinner we also have a silent auction. If you would like to donate towards the silent auction, this would be greatly appreciated! You can donate new items, hand crafted items, baked goods, gift certificates or whatever you can think of to make this a success. Please give us a starting price on your item.

We also have a work sign-up list to help in the kitchen. This is a very important job and beginning Monday November 10<sup>th</sup>, we begin preparation of our thanksgiving dinner. Please contact the preschool office or church office if you would like to help in the kitchen. We try to do most of the preparation during preschool hours. Everyone may leave at NOON.

De-boning turkeys is a big part of the thanksgiving dinner. We desperately need help in tearing the meat off the bones and placing the meat in pans. There is a sign-up list for church members and preschool parents to help in de-boning. De-boning usually starts around 12:30 pm. If you can save the date, Thursday November the 13<sup>th</sup> to help de-bone, this would be greatly appreciated! Sign up if you can help.

Breads and desserts may be brought in on Wednesday and Thursday November 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> in the morning. If you would like to purchase bread that is closest to homemade, go to Bill's Country Market. If you would like to bake Mrs. Smith's pies, that would be great also. We try not to make this difficult for anyone, so just remember to be simple.

**Purchase Your Tickets NOW for \$9.00.** Once we reach our limit of 500 tickets sold, no tickets will be sold after that time. The kitchen is only equipped to handle about 500 plates. No tickets sold the night of the dinner. Remember that this is a fundraiser and by the time we pay to pit smoke the turkeys, purchase the dry goods and ingredients for the dressing, it is worthwhile to have this fundraiser! Please have all items here at the preschool by Wednesday, November 5th. Can goods and turkey money may be brought in as soon as possible.



This year's event will be featuring an art display. Breanne Nelson, one of the room mothers, will donate her time to help the children create their masterpiece. Each child will be making a priceless keepsake. Parents will have the opportunity to make a donation to purchase their child's masterpiece the night of the Thanksgiving Dinner!
