You are Nothing Minor

The center and focus of our lives as Christians is and should always be focused on Jesus! He is what we are all about. It's not about the good things we do or say. It's not about the great things we say about or to others. As followers of Jesus, we are His disciples because of Jesus! That means there is no one greater or lesser in the kingdom of God. We are not mere minor characters on the scene for the history books. Jesus died for all and His blood atones for everyone's sin.

Starting this month, we continue our central focus on Jesus: His life, death, and resurrection for us. Our meditations for our Lenten midweek gatherings for worship will be constructed for us by certain minor characters of Jesus' passion. Through them we will be reminded of Jesus' words, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life, no one comes to the Father except through Me!"

Our first gathering, Malchus will speak to us about how we should respond to those who have wronged us in the shadow of Jesus' cross.

Next, a false witness bears to us about how often we lie and deceive with fictional stories.

Third, the bystander reminds us how many times we deny Jesus but how He never denies us.

Fourth, an Elder shows us how much we are worth.

Fifth, a more common character of Barabbas will tell us that people are truly crazy or out of their minds while Jesus always has us in mind.

And finally, Simon from Cyrene helps us to examine our lives in carrying the cross of Jesus for others to see.

As the minor prophets in the Old Testament point the focus on God's saving actions ultimately through His Son, Jesus; so also, minor characters of the Passion help us focus on Jesus and what He's done to make us more than minor people. He makes us His People!

Everyone is welcomed to stay after church in the narthex each Sunday for coffee and cookies giving time to fellowship among each other.







REGISTRATION

Fall Registration will begin Wednesday, March 1, 2017 and end on Friday, March 31, 2016. This is for the families that are enrolled in the program now. This is giving you first chance to enroll your child for the 2017-2018 school year. You may pick up a packet on Wednesday, March 1st in the preschool office.

After March 31st, the enrollment is open to the waiting list and public. If you are planning to have your child attend Trinity, please come by the office and pick up a packet and bring it back, along with the registration fee.

Non-refundable registration fee for the 2017-2018 school year is \$80.00. For the early registration, and for the month of March only, and for the ones in the program now, will have a discount from \$80.00 to \$65.00 until March 31st. Beginning April 1st, the registration will be \$80.00.

Along with the registration fee, I must have all enrollment forms completed and turned into the office. Remember that fall registration is beginning Wednesday, March 1st and will end on Friday, March 31st, for the price of \$65.00 and this is only for the ones that are in the program NOW! Registration will be first come first basis.

Dr. Seuss's Birthday – In March schools across the United States will celebrate the birthday of one of the most beloved children's authors of our time, Dr. Seuss. Children will celebrate and honor his birthday by participating in fun activities, playing games, and reading his much-adored books.

Beth Franke, retired Librarian, will come to the preschool to read to the children on Friday, March 3rd.

Dr. Seuss's birthday is March 2; 1904 and his birth name is Theodor Seuss Geisel. A few of the classes are asking for parents to come and read to the children. Check with your child's teacher if they would like for you to volunteer and read to the children.

Spring Pictures! Stephanie Meyer from Stephanie K Photography will come to the preschool to take spring pictures of the children. Please dress your child in spring attire.

Stephanie will be here on Wednesday, March 22nd beginning at 8:30 am. Please be sure to fill out your order form and return it to the office with your money by Friday, March 10th. No pictures will be taken without the required form and money.

Wear Orange Day! On Friday, March 10th the children can wear the color ORANGE to school to reinforce the color for the month.

Family of the Week! Family of the week is a program we have that helps children share their family with everyone at preschool and church. Each week a family will be chosen to be Family of the Week.

The Bible verse for the month is: “I will be with you always”. (Matthew 28:20). The children will learn The Ninth Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor’s house. *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor’s inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

The children will learn The Tenth Commandment: You shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, worker or animals. What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor’s wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.



Stranger Danger! The children are ready for Retired Trooper Gary Pflughaupt to come to preschool. He will be here on Thursday March 2nd at 10:00 am to talk to the children about Stranger Danger.

Mr. Gary will talk to the children about not leaving with someone you do not know, not to take anything from a stranger, especially candy, an animal, money or a ride in a vehicle. Only talk to another person if your mom or dad or the person you are with says it is alright and know how and when to call 911.

Chairmen Reports

- The January 31, 2017, Treasurer's report, along with contributions and expenses for the month, were presented. The cash balance in the General Fund is \$104,922.29. The Building Fund balance is \$61,834.69 and the Designated Funds balance is \$52,095.94. The Total of all Funds is \$218,852.92. The General Fund contributions for January were \$18,541.40 and General Fund expenditures were \$17,135.84.
- After discussion, a motion was made by Lee Hobratschk to transfer the Special Service funds (Advent, Thanksgiving and Christmas services) into the General Fund. The motion was seconded by Carol Jean Hauschild. All Council members approved and the motion passed.
- Thrivent Choice Dollars for our church totaled \$12,332.00 for the year 2016.

- Contribution envelopes for 2018 will be ordered soon.

Lee Hobratschk – Elder chairman

- The Elders will review the list of delinquent members to determine how to proceed.
- Plans are being made for Boy Scout Sunday.
