When Your Hut Is Burning

There will be a lot of tough, unexplained things that happen to us. It is easy to blame God and get discouraged when things go wrong in our lives. We should not lose heart though because God is still working in our lives. Even in the midst of pain and suffering, He is there. So remember, the next time your hut is burning to the ground, it might be a smoke signal that summons your rescue.

For all the negative things we may say to ourselves, God has a positive statement. We might think, "It is impossible," but God says, "All things are possible." We frequently say, "I can't go on," but God says, "My grace is sufficient for you." We often say, "I can't manage," but God says, "I will supply all your needs." We might say, "I feel all alone," but God says, "I will never leave you or forsake you."

MINUTES OF TRINITY LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING April 10, 2017

The Trinity Lutheran Church Council meeting was called to order by Vice President, Ron Hartmann. The meeting was opened with prayer by Pastor Bersche. Susie Hartmann presented the devotion "I Love You Jesus."

The Minutes from the meeting held on March 13, 2017 were presented for review and approval. A motion was made by Becky Tipton, seconded by Susie Hartmann to accept the minutes as presented. All Council members approved and the motion passed.

Unfinished/Old Business

- The contract for the rental of the gym was presented for review. This was tabled until the next meeting for more discussion.
- The Council discussed where the funds that were raised from the Lenten soup suppers should be placed. It was decided that each group that sponsors a soup supper will determine where the funds should go.

Chairmen Reports

Carol Jean Hauschild – Treasurer

- The March 31, 2017, Treasurer's report, along with contributions and expenses for the month, were presented. The cash balance in the General Fund is \$113,371.56. The Building Fund balance is \$50,468.23 and the Designated Funds balance is \$47,052.75. These will be the correct balances after the purchase amount of the new air conditioner is re-classed to the correct fund. The Total of all Funds is \$210,892.54.

Jerry Leiber – Stewardship Chairman

- Nothing to report

Lee Hobratschk – Elder Chairman

- Lee reported that the video/recording equipment in the choir loft is still not working. They are attempting to resolve the problem, but a new camera may need to be purchased.

Ron Hartmann – Vice President

- Nothing to report

Pastor Bersche

- Pastor reported that in addition to visiting our shut-ins at the nursing home, he also visits two members who are not able to attend church services at this time.
- The Council discussed the upcoming Holy Week services. Pastor noted that on Maundy Thursday, the Altar will be stripped of all paraments, as well as the candles. Also, the Lord's Supper will be served at all four of the services.
- Pastor will be attending a Pastor's Conference on May 1st and 2nd.
- On May 3, 2017, the Confirmation examination will take place, with Confirmation taking place on May 7th. There are 7 confirmands.
- Preschool graduation will be on May 21st, 2017.
- On Monday, May 22nd, Pastor will be undergoing his surgery.

Valerie Engelbrecht – Board of Education

- The Youth will be holding the church service on April 30th, 2017.
- The Youth will have carnations on Mother's Day to hand out.

- Vacation Bible School will take place June 20th thru June 22nd at 6 p.m. until 8 p.m.
- Valerie also reported that the Easter egg hunt that took place on Palm Sunday was a success.

- The Council discussed the possibility of purchasing banners to be displayed in the church parking lot or at other locations on the church grounds. These banners will advertise events that are happening at Trinity.
- The next Evangelism meeting is April 27th, at 5:30 p.m.

Susie Hartmann – Fellowship Chairman

- The Fellowship committee proposed that the supplies in the church's kitchen be shared between the different groups. This included items such as paper goods, cups, knives and forks, sugar, coffee, etc. This proposal will not include the Preschool or the supplies for the annual Church barbecue. The Fellowship committee will monitor and purchase the supplies. Becky Tipton made a motion that the kitchen supplies be combined and shared. Ruth Szymanski seconded the motion. All Council members approved, and the motion passed.
- The Council also discussed having an Elder assist Pastor with baptisms. Lee Hnbratschk will discuss this with the Elders.

Bill Blume – Trustee Chairman

- A new ice machine is in the process of being purchased.
- The Church landscaping for spring has been completed.
- The Trustee committee is looking for someone to refinish the front entry doors to the Church.
- The new air conditioning system has been completed.
