Live Like There's Forever!

Live like there's no tomorrow! That expression is some people's life motto. That idiom means simply to live with reckless abandonment. And some do live as if they have no regard for the future. It goes along the words which St. Paul quotes in 1 Corinthians 15:32- "Let us eat and drink for tomorrow we die."

One could have an opposite view of this attitude though. For if there is no tomorrow then a person might live delicately so as to possibly conserve one's days left upon the face of the earth. This idea comes across from many people this past year during the pandemic. They were extra, extra cautious in everything: never leaving the house, every package that comes to the door must be sanitized, mail must also be sanitized, etc. Yet in this idea, the Bible reminds us that you cannot add any time to your life on the face of the earth.

St. Paul reminds us, regardless of our situation whether pandemic or not, we are to live life because there is forever. St. Paul says,

"Behold! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed. For this perishable body must put on the imperishable, and this mortal body must put on immortality. When the perishable puts on the imperishable, and the mortal puts on immortality, then shall come to pass the saying that is written:

"Death is swallowed up in victory."

"O death, where is your victory?

O death, where is your sting?"

The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." 1 Corinthians 15:51-58 ESV



Trinity Lutheran Preschool is getting closer to reopening. I have renewed our ninety day suspension for the third and last time. Our first request for a ninety day suspension was back in September. The second ninety suspension was January of this year and our third and last request of ninety day suspension is this month in April to reopen the day after Labor Day.

Suspension sounds like trouble but this is the procedure to have all paper work updated to reopen each ninety days.

As of right now without advertising, we have twenty-eight children

enrolled for the fall. With ratios low we can have forty-eight

children at the most. I am praying by June or July we can go back to our regular licensed ratios of children.

State Licensing will come sometime in August to inspect the building and property to make sure all compliances are up to date. She will inspect all the paper work pertaining to me as the director and all staff and children's papers.

A lot of changes been a lot of changes taken place since the Preschool Bylaws have been updated. I am not very good with changes and I learned to balance negative thoughts with positive ones and know I am doing my best in these tough situations. Sometimes it takes time to see the whole picture of the changes, to see that these changes are for the best, knowing you have the love, support, care and encouragement of the Preschool Board, Church Council, Elders' and our Congregation.

The total contributions for the year 2021 were \$41,700.60, while the total expenses for the year were \$42,487.49.
