Believe it or not, pastors do get frustrated! Yes, we're human and sinful (very sinful at that). I remember one of the times I was the most frustrated. It happened over a decade ago in my former parish in west Texas. A parishioner of mine after the fact was complaining that I didn't visit them in the hospital. They would have a very good reason for their complaint except for the fact that I NEVER KNEW THEY WERE IN THE HOSPITAL. The person never told me. They assumed that a loved one or close relative said something, but they didn't. I was in the dark and very frustrated.

You may not be aware of this but most of the time (and this is sad to say) the pastor is the last one to know. Everyone else knows the happenings of the church such as who is sick, in the hospital, needing assistance but they just assume that the pastor knows, which in most cases he doesn't.

That one time when I was really frustrated about the hospital visit, I had to vent out my frustrations to someone. So, I went to the former pastor of the parish who knew the congregation very well. He gave me really good advice. He said to me, "Ken, when I was the pastor of this church every now and then I'd step out the office door. Then I take the few steps outside the church door and stand by the bell tower. I would then look up to heaven and say, 'Lord, tell me who is sick and in the hospital this week?" I had to laugh at his response to my complaint. Then I asked him, "Did God ever respond and tell you exactly who was in the hospital?" To that, he just shook his head.

So, if you as a follower of Christ and a parishioner of Trinity Lutheran Church in Sealy, Texas, then please let me know by calling the church office and telling us when and where you go into the hospital. That is if you want your pastor to visit you. (Don't forget there are numerous hospitals in the area.) Otherwise, I will not know. Or if I find out by other means, I might assume you don't want to be visited. I've also come across some folks who want complete privacy at the hospital, even from their pastor. Yet you could still inform me about your trip to the hospital and not tell me the location. That way I will continue to keep you in my personal prayers each day.

As always, I will continue to pray for all of you as I hope you also pray for me. Continue in the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ and remember, HE LOVES YOU even in times of frustration. We are saved by God's grace through faith alone in Jesus Christ's death and resurrection for the forgiveness of sins. It is in His forgiveness that we serve each other every day.

Henry Baade and Laura Baade were cousins of George Baade. Both had a hard time finding out information about George along with George's friend Larry. Henry and Laura did not know that George passed until I called them.

Henry, which was not easy, finally got information about the stepdaughter, Joy Bencio, by certified letter. At this time Joy was stuck in Manilla in the Philippines for nine weeks due to the airport shut down. Joy lives in New York and is Director of Nursing and has been in the U. S. for thirty years.

This is what Henry found out. George never really communicated to Nelda or Joy about his cousins.

After Nelda, George's wife passed, Joy wanted to make sure George was taken care of and placed him in Veranda House. George was on medication for his dementia but would not take his medication as directed and was getting worse. From Veranda House, Joy moved George to Caydance in Katy.  service. Motion passed 5-0. The

- There was discussion of returning Communion on fifth Sundays. There was no motion made so the Fifth Sunday Communion Service died for lack of a motion.
- Organist/Pianist Janis Pless has stepped down as our organist/pianist. We are currently looking for someone to fill her position.
