We Focus on Jesus

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus,

the Founder and Perfecter of our faith, Who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2

The season of Lent will soon be upon us. Ash Wednesday (March 5, 2025) marks the beginning of the penitential season. And that's it-Lent is the penitential season, or in other words, our focus isn't upon our goodness but upon our badness and Jesus' forgiveness through His suffering, death, and resurrection.

Too often, we focus only on ourselves. Sadly, it happens even during Lent especially with the question, "What are you giving up for Lent?" Notice the question- what are YOU giving up for Lent? The focus is on you and not on Jesus. Only when our focus is on Jesus then one can give something up for Lent but it must be in that order. Yet even then, the danger involved is still in our focus.

This Lent we focus on our Savior. Jesus, the Son of God who gave up all to take upon Himself our sins. His focus is on us and not Himself. He died on the cross not to gain glory for Himself but to gain forgiveness for us. He always and fully focuses on us, so let us focus on Him.

May we also along with the saints of old declare: "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world!"

Fall Pre-registration for 2025-2026 school year begins March 1st and ends March 31st. Preregistration is open for the preschool families that

are currently in the program as of now, AND to new students from the community that are not enrolled.

The non-refundable pre- registration fee for Trinity Lutheran Preschool is \$95.00 for students new to the school and \$85.00 for students currently enrolled.

For the month of March ONLY, fall registration will be at a reduced price for both the families enrolled now and for the community. Once April 1st arrives registration will revert to the regular price of \$125.00 for students new to the school.

Registration packets are ready for you to pick up in the preschool office. If you are planning to have your child attend Trinity, please come by the office and pick up a packet, fill out enrollment forms and return the packet with the registration fee before Sunday, March 31st.
