## Not a Dead End

There lies a gravel country road that stretches out past the horizon. Close to the end of that road is a cemetery. In that cemetery lies large

tomb markers and some small ones. There is no fence around the graveyard just a tree here and there as the wild wind breezes through the green grass.

Every now and then, families show up to visit their deceased family members. It's a reminder that this location is a place for tears and sometimes a time for laughter. Occasionally, a person in the community passes away and they are then buried in the midst of all the other tombs in the cemetery.

The oddest sight about this cemetery is the road sign that the county put up. It stands next to the road with its diamond shape. It stands at the beginning of the cemetery along the road. One takes another look and they will see that the road continues on for a while. But there in black letters on a gold background are the two words:

**DEAD** 

**END** 

It is sad to say but many people would wish that this is their dead end but it is not. Regardless of who we are, life does not end after temporal death. Scripture reminds us of the great judgment. Jesus, the judge sits on His throne and separates people as a shepherd separates sheep from the goats. Those on His right are blessed and enter eternal life while the others, the goats, will go to eternal punishment.

The dead end doesn't exist especially for us in Christ Jesus. He died to take away our sins. His body without decay lay in the grave. On the third day He rose again and showed Himself to His disciples. He still shows Himself to us today in His Word, in Holy Baptism, and in His Supper. There He offers us His forgiveness and everlasting life.

There is No "Dead End"! Because He lives, we live also. And nothing can snatch us out of His loving, forgiving hands. God bless you and your family as we continue to celebrate Jesus' resurrection and our resurrection in Him.
